Which tests are useful – and which one is not? Which steps are necessary to stabilize an emergency patient? Cardiology and Emergency made easy - case presentations and how to solve cases in private practice. In the afternoon we use the new information from the Hot Topic session to solve cardiac and emergency cases and to treat those cases accordingly. After this seminar, you will solve more challenging cardio and emergency cases!

Thursday	Neurology and Nutrition <i>P. Koelle and A. Fischer</i>	In this workshop, participants will work through nutritional and neurological case examples. Pros and cons of various diagnostic tests, pitfalls to a correct diagnosis and details of the successful therapy will be discussed. Active participation and discussions are expected and will maximise the learning experience, enhanced by the limited number of attending veterinarians.
Friday	Oncology <i>A. Soukup and S. Lauer</i>	Two of the most important therapy possibilities in the oncology – Surgery and Radiation therapy. How to use efficiently the combinations of these two methods to maximize the success of treatment and where it is better to use both the options as solo-therapy? These are exactly the points for discussion!
