Which tests are useful – and which one is not? Which steps are necessary to stabilize an emergency patient? In the afternoon we use the new information from the Hot Topic session to solve cardiac and emergency cases and to treat those cases accordingly. After this seminar, you will solve more challenging cardio and emergency cases!

We will cover the most important diseases and discuss with the participants the clinical work-up and treatment options! Wednesday	<b>Nutrition and Neurology</b>  <i>P. Koelle and S. Dörfelt</i>	In this workshop, participants will work through nutritional and neurological case examples. Pros and cons of various diagnostic tests, pitfalls to a correct diagnosis and details of the successful therapy will be discussed. Active participation and discussions are expected and will maximise the learning experience, enhanced by the limited number of attending veterinarians.
